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At the outset, **Dr. S. Sudhakara Reddy**, Principal & Chairman of the Academic Council, welcomed the Members to the 11th Academic Council Meeting and explained the composition and functions of the Academic Council as per the revised UGC guidelines 2018 for the autonomous colleges. The chairman, then, placed on record the Action Taken on the minutes of the previous Academic Council Meeting, proposal for exemption of any TWO theory subjects up to a maximum of 6 credits for B.Tech. Students admitted during the year 2015-16, relaxation of promotion rule of B.Tech. II year lateral entry students in line with latest JNTUH guidelines. The chairman stated that 11th BoS meetings for various department Boards were conducted from 21-06-2019 to 09-07-2019 and he presented the consolidated BoS minutes. Later, he briefly appraised the members on the progress made on various Academic matters since the 10th Academic Council meeting. He also explained the Academic Calendar, List of students passed and detained (due to lack of attendance/credits), Result analysis and Placement details.

After detailed discussion and observations, the following resolutions have been made and **approved** by the Academic Council Members agenda point wise.

Agenda Point 1: Action Taken Report of the 10th Academic Council meeting.

Resolution / Approval:

Action taken report relating to the 10th Academic Council Meeting was appraised to the members of the council.

Agenda Point 2(a): Several representations were received from the students of MR15 regulations of this institution to consider exemption of any two theory subjects/ courses - for discussion and consideration as indicated.

Resolution / Approval:

MR15 regulations as the start of CBCS and our affiliating University, JNTUH provided exemption of credits to students of B. Tech. programme admitted in 2015 – 16 academic year, vide Letter No. EB/330/2019, dated 03-07-2019. In view of the above, even though the exemption is for non CBCS R15 regulations and not related to CBCS regulations, the Council members considered this transitory regulations and discussed in detail the University exemption and agreed to consider giving a relaxation of 2 theory subjects equivalent to a maximum of 6 credits for MR15 CBCS regulation students also. However this relaxation has been given to students of 2015-19 batch only. The students who want to opt for the exemption of 2 theory subjects up to 6 credits should apply for it with an undertaking which states that the option is exercised with detailed understanding of repercussions. An awareness programme is to be conducted for MR 15 (2015 – 19) batch of students, including their parents, by respective HoDs.

However this relaxation is not applicable for 2016 - 20 batch students even though they come under MR15 Regulations. An undertaking should be taken from 2016 -20 batch students with regard to regulations.

Agenda Point 2(b): In view of JNTUH proceedings No: A1/2557/XL SCAS/2019 (3) dated: 31.05.2019 – Relaxation of promotion rule for B.Tech. II year Lateral Entry students from 60% to of 50% of total credits up to II year II semester from all relevant regular and supplementary exams for promoting them to III year from the Academic year 2019-20, as against the currently in vogue "to securing 60% of the registered credits up to II Year II Semester" in UG (B.Tech.) programmes as indicated for discussion and consideration.

Resolution / Approval:

It is unanimously approved by the members of the council, in line with the JNTUH proceedings No: A1/2557/XL SCAS/2019 (3) dated: 31.05.2019, to relax promotion rule for B.Tech. II year Lateral Entry students from 60% to of 50% of total credits up to II year II semester from all relevant regular

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and supplementary exams for promoting them to III year from the Academic year 2019-20, as against the currently in vogue "to securing 60% of the registered credits up to II Year II Semester" in UG (B.Tech.) programmes as indicated below.

Agenda Point 3: Discuss and review other MR18 Academic Regulations of all UG and PG courses.

Resolution / Approval:

The other Academic Regulations as approved by the various Boards of studies relating to different branches of U.G.(B.Tech.) and P.G. (M. Tech. & MBA) programmes are unanimously approved.

Agenda Point 4: Discuss and review of MR18 Course structure and syllabus of all UG and PG courses forwarded from respective Boards of BoS.

Resolution / Approval:

The MR 18 Course Structure and Syllabi of all UG (B.Tech.) and PG (M.Tech. & MBA) programmesare approved to be adopted for the academic year 2019-2020 as approved by various Boards of studies.

Agenda Point 5: Approval of Academic Calendar of B.Tech., M.Tech., and MBA Programmes for the Academic Year 2019-20.

Resolution / Approval:

The academic calendar for the year 2019-2020, as proposed and attached as Annexure, is approved.

Agenda Point 6 (a): Ratification of the Results of all UG, PG courses for the academic year 2018-19 (keeping in view the agenda point no 2.a as stated above).

Resolution / Approval:

The Academic council has ratified the results of all UG (B.Tech.) and PG (M.Tech. & MBA) for the academic year 2018-2019, keeping in view the approval point No. 2 (a).

Agenda Point 6 (b): Ratification of the List of detained students (Due to lack of Credits / Attendance) during the academic year 2018-19 (keeping in view the agenda point no 2.b stated above).

Resolution / Approval:

The Academic council has ratified the list of detained students due to lack of credits / attendance during the academic year 2018-19, keeping in view the approved point No. 2 (b) stated above.

Financial aid to the needy and deserving students for attending the Skill Development Programmes conducted in the college from the Alumni Association funds is recommended.

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Agenda Point 7(c): Recommendation of Prizes and medals awarding to meritorious students for their academic achievements/ toppers and for sports and extra-curricular activities.

Resolution / Approval:

Prizes and medals to meritorious students for academic achievements and to toppers in sports and extra-curricular activities are recommended.

Resolution / Approval:

Maintenance and functioning of the play-grounds and hostels are recommended.
