Resolution / Approval: The Academic Council has ratified the list of Subject Experts from outside the college, nominated to various Boards of BoS.



Auxiliary Minutes

1. The Academic Council has suggested for registration of students for Swayam / MOOCs courses. It has further stated that credit exemption up to 6 credits could be allowed for the students that complete the courses successfully.
2. The Council also suggested that subjects/courses to be registered by students can be identified and shortlisted based on the contents of existing Academic Syllabus.
3. The Council has proposed to consider offering the courses of IV-II in IV-I so as to allow the students to be occupied with placement and internship activities in IV-II semester. A condition of CGPA 7 or above can be stipulated.
4. The council also proposed introduction of Career Advancement Scheme (CAS). It advised the college to observe the modalities from other Engineering colleges which are already implementing the same.
