At the outset, **Dr. S. Sudhakara Reddy**, Principal & Chairman of the Academic Council, welcomes the Members to the 9<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting. The chairman placed on record, the Academic Regulations, Course structures along with syllabai for the Under Graduate and Post Graduate programmes in Engineering and MBA offered by the college for the batches admitting from the academic year 2018-19 onwards. The 9<sup>th</sup> BOS meetings for various department Boards were conducted from 15-06-2018 to 03-07-2018 and the consolidated BOS minutes were presented. Later, he briefly appraised the members on the progress made on various Academic matters since the 8<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2017 along with the Action taken Report. He also explained the Academic Calendar, List of detained students due to lack of attendance/credits, Result analysis and Placement details.

After careful, detailed discussion and observations, the following resolutions have been made and **approved** by the Academic Council members (for the batches admitting from the Academic Year 2018-19 onwards)

1. The MR18 Academic Regulations of all UG (B.Tech in CE, EEE, ME, ECE, CSE, IT and Mi.E) and PG (M.Tech in SE, EPS, TE, MD and CSE) and MBA programmes with effect from the Academic Year 2018-19.
2. The MR18 Academic Regulations -Course structure and syllabus of all UG programmes in Engineering (B.Tech in CE, EEE, ME, ECE, CSE, IT and Mi.E) starting from academic year 2018-19 with 160 credits for the entire B.Tech. programme.

3. Academic council unanimously resolved to change the title of the Matrices and Calculus course as “Engineering Mathematics- I” and title of the Differential equations and advanced calculus course as “Engineering Mathematics-II”.
4. Academic council unanimously resolved to convert Gender Sensitization Lab (Mandatory) course to Gender Sensitization theory (Mandatory) course.
5. The MR18 Academic Regulations -Course structure and syllabus of all PG programmes in Engineering (M.Tech in SE, EPS, TE, MD and CSE) starting from academic year 2018-19 with 68 credits for the entire M.Tech. programme.
6. Academic council unanimously resolved to be made Research Methodology & IPR course in PG programmes in Engineering (TE and MD) as core course under HSMC category with 2 credits (2 lecture Hours) instead of Audit Course.
7. The MR18 Academic Regulations -Course structure and syllabus for MBA programme starting from academic year 2018-19 with 104 credits for the entire MBA programme.
8. Distribution of Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) and Semester End Examination (SEE) for
  - a. all UG programmes in Engineering (B.Tech in CE,EEE,ME,ECE,CSE,IT and Mi.E) - 25 marks as CIE and 75 marks as SEE. (Students - to earn credits allotted to each Subject/ Course, he / she needs to secure not less than 35% marks in the Semester End Examination and with a minimum of 40% of the (CIE and SEE together) total marks allocated for the course )
  - b. all PG programmes in Engineering (M.Tech in SE, EPS, TE, MD and CSE) - 40 marks as CIE and 60 marks as SEE (Students - to earn credits allotted to each Subject/ Course, he / she needs to secure not less than 40% marks in the Semester End Examination and with a minimum of 50% of the (CIE and SEE together) total marks allocated for the course )
  - c. For MBA programme - 40 marks as CIE and 60 marks as SEE (Students - to earn credits allotted to each Subject/ Course, he / she need to secure not less than 40% marks in the Semester End Examination and with a minimum of 50% of the (CIE and SEE together) total marks allocated for the course )

9. Using JNTUH logo and modifications in MREC (A) UG and PG marks memo's / Grade sheets from the academic year 2018-19.



**Auxiliary Minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting  
held on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

1. The MR18 regulations for UG programmes will be continued for next four years, for PG programmes (M.Tech., MBA) will be continued two years.
2. The Academic Council suggested to constituting a committee to study the feasibility for inclusion of New Programmes (UG & PG) / Change in intake (UG & PG) / Closure of Programmes (UG & PG) from the academic year 2019-20 onwards. The committee will consider to study all UG, PG programmes running in the institute and new programmes that can be proposed from the academic year 2019-20, which are successfully running in other reputed colleges. The committee has to submit a detailed report on suitability of the programmes as per the current industry requirement in the region, availability of staff and lab establishments. The Academic Council authorized the principal for taking suitable decision based on committee report.
3. Members suggested, in future, 20% of credits of total required credits can be earned through MOOC/NPTEL online certification courses without insisting of their physical attendance.
4. Suggested commencement of Academic Year on first Monday of July in every year.
